HOW DO I BUY TICKETS?

Most tickets are \$15 (Five/5ths tickets are \$20). We strongly encourage buying your tickets online at AtlantaFringe.org. The box office at each venue opens one hour before the first show of the day. At-the-door tickets for each show will be on sale approximately 45 minutes before showtime. We will not be accepting cash.

WHAT IF I WANT A FESTIVAL PASS?

Multi-show passes are available online at AtlantaFringe.org, at Fringe HQ (see page 8), or at each venue. Passes are a great way to see more shows for less dough! Plus, you can share them with your friends.

SEATING INFO

SEATING POLICY

Seating is general admission for each and every show, for single ticket buyers and pass holders. All seating is first come, first served—even for pass holders. Unclaimed pre-purchased tickets will be RELEASED 5 minutes before show time. Late seating will be at the discretion of each production, per the artists' choice—so it's not guaranteed. Be sure to plan accordingly!

Every person (adults and children ages 2 & up) attending a Fringe performance must have a ticket. Children under age 2 are free. In the event of sold-out performances, children under 2 are expected to sit in their parent's lap. Car seats or carriers will not be allowed to take up seats. Kids Fringe is, of course, free, but please reserve your

seats at AtlantaFringe.org in advance for capacity reasons.

WHAT IF I SHOW UP LATE?

All shows in the Atlanta Fringe Festival start ON TIME. We do not hold houses because it would throw the whole schedule off course. We all know Atlanta traffic can be atrocious. Please give yourself plenty of time to get to your venue and park. Most productions perform 3 times; if you miss one showtime, you'll have other opportunities to see it. All sales are final. We do not issue refunds, but you may exchange your ticket for another showtime.
