HOW DO I BUY TICKETS?

We strongly encourage buying your tickets online in advance at AtlantaFringe.org. The box office at each venue opens one hour before the first show of the day. At-the-door tickets for each show will be on sale approximately 45 minutes before showtime. We will not be accepting cash.

Most tickets are \$18 (Five/5ths tickets are \$25 online, \$30 at the door). We strongly encourage buying your tickets online at AtlantaFringe.org. The box office at each venue opens one hour before the first show of the day. At-the-door tickets for each show will be on sale approximately 45 minutes before showtime. **We will not be accepting cash.**

WHAT IF I WANT A FESTIVAL PASS?

Multi-show passes are available online at AtlantaFringe.org, at Fringe HQ, or at each venue. Passes are a great way to see more shows for less dough! Plus, you can share them with your friends and they're good for some cool deals around town!

SEATING INFO



SEATING POLICY

Seating is general admission for each and every show, for single ticket buyers and pass holders. Unclaimed pre-purchased tickets will be RELEASED 5 minutes before show time. Late seating will be at the discretion of each production, per the artists' choice—so it's not guaranteed. Be sure to plan accordingly!

Every person (adults and children ages 2 & up) attending a Fringe performance must have a ticket. Children under age 2 are free. In the event of sold-out performances, children under 2 are expected to sit in their parent's lap. Car seats or carriers will not be allowed to take up seats. Kids Fringe is, of course, free, but please reserve your seats at AtlantaFringe.org in advance for capacity reasons.

WHAT IF I SHOW UP LATE?

All shows in the Atlanta Fringe Festival start ON TIME. We do not hold houses because it would throw the whole schedule off course. We all know Atlanta traffic can be atrocious. Please give yourself plenty of time to get to your venue and park. Most productions perform 5 times; if you miss one showtime, you'll have other opportunities to see it. **All sales are final. We do not issue refunds,** but you may exchange your ticket for another showtime for the same production.

And now a word from our EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Welcome to the 14th Atlanta Fringe Festival! We are dedicated to presenting bold, independent artists and diverse voices to adventurous audiences who want to discover, engage, and connect with exciting new work. If you're holding this program, that means you're probably one or the other - or both! Thank you for being here. If I may offer some tips for the best Fringe experience?

- 1. Discover!** Be open to the NEW! There's no algorithm curating anything here; it's all up to you. Pick a show at random. Go see something you'd never check out in "normal" life. Talk to a stranger about the show you just saw and see what they've enjoyed. With tickets under \$20 and no show longer than an hour, it's super easy to sample and experiment. You may not only discover a new favorite show or artists, but a new favorite performing art form!
- 2. Connect!** Fringe festivals create an amazing energy because everyone is in it together. I call it "Trench Artfare" because you can really bond over all the stuff that makes a Fringe so exciting and so challenging: rushing from one show to the next, bemoaning that you're going to miss that one production because you just can't fit it into your schedule, shoving some food in your face between showtimes. Artists, staff, program directors, audiences - we all get it! It creates an instant camaraderie with everyone you meet. Your new best friends await!
- 3. Enjoy the challenge!** Fringes challenge artists with space and time limitations. Fringes challenge audiences to conspiracy-board an exciting but complicated schedule (and arrive on time!). Fringes challenge festival producers to juggle multiple venues' and 50+ different productions' worth of priorities and needs. Fringes challenge everyone involved - that's how we grow, change, become large! As T.S. Eliot once said, "If you aren't in over your head, how do you know how tall you are?"

Welcome to Fringe. Welcome to the trenches. This is gonna be fun!

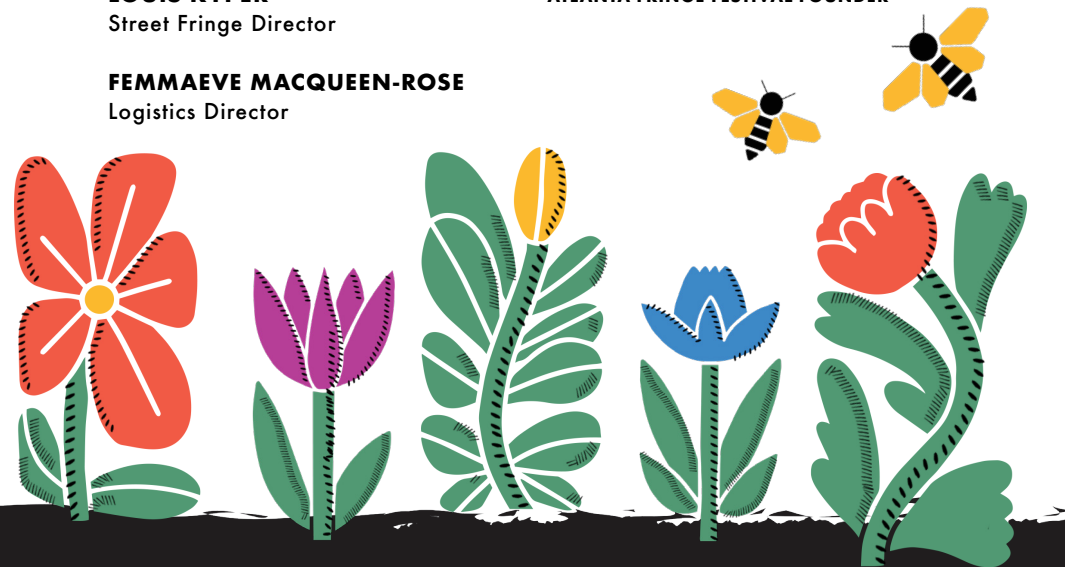

SO, WHAT IS FRINGE?

In 1947 the Edinburgh Arts Festival launched, and several artists who were not invited to participate decided to capitalize on the crowds and set up their own shows in venues just on the outskirts of the festival. A theatre critic wrote, "Some interesting work is happening on the fringes of the festival," and the Edinburgh Festival Fringe was born.

Now, it sells 2.5 million tickets for over 4,000 registered shows every single year, and there are more than 300 fringe festivals worldwide! Some incredibly popular things were born or gained mainstream attention at fringe festivals, including musicals like *Stomp*, *SIX: The Musical*, and *Jerry Springer: The Opera*; TV shows like *Baby Reindeer*, *Fleabag*, *Kim's Convenience*, and *Flight of the Conchords*; plays like *Rosencrantz and Guildenstern Are Dead*; and the Oscar-winning movie *The King's Speech*.

WHAT IS ATLANTA FRINGE?

Attracted by the creative freedom and lack of gatekeeping found at a Fringe festival, independent Atlanta comedy theatre ensemble **Twinhead Theatre** decided Atlanta needed a Fringe.

We decided to go with the Canadian fringe model: venues and staff provided, lineup uncurated and chosen by lottery, and 100% of ticket sales back to the artists. Our first festival was in 2012, and we have been presenting bold and exciting works by artists from all over the world ever since!

WHAT'S WITH THE BEE?

When our Design Director was developing our brand identity, she learned that Georgia's state insect is the honey bee. She immediately saw the correlation between the honey bees diligently working together to build their hive, creating something sweet and the work that AFF is doing for the performing arts community. We're *BUILDING A HIVE FOR ARTISTS TO THRIVE!* (hello, tagline!) So now the Honey Bee proudly represents us wherever we go.

LOOK HOW FAR WE'VE COME!

- 2010** Our Fringe journey began
- 2011** Friendraisers including "Get Your Buzz On" at Sutra Lounge, the first of five "Easter Art Hunts", and "Big Summer Buzz" at Melvin Gallery (now Ladybird)
- 2012** Our First Festival! - Live and Fringe Audio
- 2013** Atlanta Fringe Festival wins Creative Loafing's Best New Trend in the Arts
- 2017** We took this year off, but presented Phantasmagoria's *Through the Tales Darkly* and produced our first Five/5ths which was *The Karate Kid*. Ralph Macchio and some of the cast and crew of *Cobra Kai* loved it!
- 2020** Fringe Audio only 🐝
- 2021** Virtual Fringe Festival 🐝
- 2023** Added Kids Fringe
- 2024** Added Street Fringe
- 2025** We expanded to a TWO WEEK FESTIVAL
